Public Parking and Bus Service

- Park on Venice Bl. or the **beach lot at end of Venice Bl.** (fills up early!) \$6 before 9 am, \$12 after.
- **Westminster Elementary School parking lot**, on Main St. between Brooks and Westminster Ave, for \$10. Walk two blocks west to Ocean Front Walk, then head approximately 4 blocks south to the festival site.
- Leave the car at home and take bus! **Metro Bus route #333** (\$1.25) leaves every 15 minutes all day Sat. from Union Station (or #33 from Downtown) to Windward and Pacific (only 1 block from the festival)!
- **Big Blue Bus #2** (only 75¢) leaves every 20 minutes all day Saturday from downtown Santa Monica to Windward and Pacific and back.
